

Aerial Mapping Pilot

General Description: Tenax Aerospace is seeking experienced pilots for an aerial mapping program. The Program Pilot is responsible for safety of flight and successful mission execution in support of customer requested CONUS and OCONUS data collection operations. The Program Pilot must be able to precisely fly aerial grid patterns while maintaining situational awareness of the company aircraft, his or her crew and the surrounding airspace. The Program Pilot must represent the company in a professional and respectful manner, maintain good and positive CRM, be flexible to changing conditions, be a team player and assist in the safety management process of the operations. This position is with Tenax TM, LLC, a sister company to Tenax Aerospace, LLC.

Responsibilities:

- Conduct command piloting of precise ground-track aerial surveying patterns
- Perform command pilot functions with assigned pilots and technical collection crew
- Function as Pilot in Command during flights and ensure all are conducted in compliance with applicable aviation regulations both domestic and foreign
- Ensure the aircraft is operated in accordance with aircraft manufacturer's requirements, flight manuals, directives, company policies and specific mission procedures
- Ensure that all flight operations are performed in a safe and professional manner
- Assist as necessary in the responsibilities for aircraft upkeep, scheduling, maintenance, safety management and fueling operations as required
- Conduct pre-flight and post-flight inspections and related briefings
- Complete daily collection reports, weekly operations reports, detailed maintenance reports, and incident reports as required

- Current FAA Multi-Engine Commercial pilot license with Instrument Rating
- FAA Class II Medical Certificate
- Flight time experience: 4,500 hours total time and 1,500 hours PIC
- Restricted Radiotelephone Operators Permit
- US passport and eligible for international deployments
- Ability to obtain and maintain the required US Government DOD security clearance
- Hold a valid driver's license and pass a background check
- Read, write, speak, and understand English
- Ability to pass a thorough medical examination
- Available for extended deployments domestically and internationally

- ATP Certificate
- Gulfstream IV type rating and/or current proficiency in large cabin aircraft
- Current Government Security Clearance, Secret level or higher
- International PIC flight experience
- Prior US Government operations experience
- Experience flying ISR or airborne data collection mission profiles

- Technical Bachelor's Degree
